Summary of Responsibilities:

Successful candidates will be able to work as part of a team to provide shift coverage for an Emergency Receiving and Assessment residential program within the Peel Region. Experience dealing with children who have behavioral difficulties ages 12-16 years is preferred as well as the ability to assess, interpret and record behavior in a meaningful way. The ability to build trusting relationships with children and participate in a professional treatment team approach is required.

Candidates must possess effective social skills to be a positive role model for the youth and have a strong level of familiarity with Child & Youth residential programming and assessment skills along with verbal and written communication skills, particularly with recordings and reports. You are able to work a variety of shifts including weekend and statutory holidays.

Qualifications:

- Child & Youth Work diploma from a recognized community college preferred or a related diploma or degree (BA, BSW, DSW).
- Knowledge of mental health and developmental/learning disabilities
- Must have a valid CPR, First Aid Certificate, and UMAB (understanding and managing aggressive behavior)
- A valid Ontario Driver's License with one million liability auto insurance coverage
- A current "vulnerable sector" police check.
- Up to date Immunization and Health assessment.
- Bilingual in French and English an asset

Hours of Work:

- Works on a rotational schedule, with a variety of shifts, days, evening, overnights and weekends.
