Travel Grant / Disability Application Processor: Assist the Finance Department with the review of various agency files to collect information related to medical diagnosis and travel required for medical reasons for children in the agency's care. The corresponding applications will be completed with assistance from the Child Care Workers. This student will also help develop and roll out a process for the completion of future applications. Office Administration student with experience in EXCEL and strong organizational skills will be considered an asset.
