Summary of Duties and Responsibilities:

Provides shift coverage to an eight (8) bed emergency receiving assessment program. Behaviour management experience with children ages 10-16 years required as well as the ability to assess, interpret and record behaviour in a meaningful way. Ability to build trusting relationships with children and participate in a professional team approach is required.

Qualifications:

- Child & Youth Worker diploma from a recognized community college and at least 1 year of related experience
- · Class G drivers license and daily access to a vehicle are required

Specific Skills & Experience:

- Appropriate experience in Child & Youth Work assessments.
- Behaviour management group work skills.
- Demonstrates concepts of power, privilege, and social location to the specific forms of oppression (such as LGBTTIQQ2SA, disability, race/culture, gender, religion and socio-economic status).
- Ability to relate to African-Canadian, Caribbean and Indo-Caribbean youth and an understanding of the various issues that impact this population.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills, particularly with recordings and reports.
- Strong level of familiarity with Child & Youth residential programming and assessment skills.

Hours of work:

- Part-time 24 hours per week schedule
- Works on a rotational schedule, with a variety of shifts, days, evening, overnights and weekends.
- Some 8 hour shifts and some 12 hour shifts.
