What can I expect to do in this role?

- Provide leadership to the child welfare sector around the deployment of CPIN
- Engage with senior leadership at children's aid societies (CASs) regarding the implementation of CPIN
- Provide advice on change management processes at CASs to support the successful adoption of CPIN
- Liaise with the ministry application specialists and business staff to effectively on-board CASs to CPIN
- Provide in class Train-the-Trainer sessions, support agency trainers during in class training and support the agency in use of CPIN during the Go Live period.
- Identify CAS training and change management requirements, interpret and advise on risks and issues with respect to business processes, agency policy and procedures to CPIN implementation.
- Provide advice on training, engagement and user materials for staff at CASs
- Advise the ministry on requirements and implications of specific deployment decisions
- Facilitate knowledge transfer from the CPIN Deployment Team to CASs and within the CPIN Deployment team

How Do I Qualify?

- At least 5 years front-line work experience in a children's aid society in Ontario
- Excellent understanding of CAS business processes
- Excellent understanding of the Child Protection Standards, the CFSA, and the Child Protection Policies and procedures
- Ability to provide management advice on large-scale organizational changes
- Ability to learn and effectively use new technology
- Effective written and verbal communicator able to present to a variety of audiences
