Emergency After-Hours Service Workers

This part-time position will represent the agency in child protection matters as they relate to emergency services and associated investigations and assessment. The nature of service provided will be to respond to all contacts as presented and to diffuse crisis as presented outside of regular agency hours and to stabilize events presented until cases can be assumed by regular day staff. Hours of work are from 4:30 pm to 8:30 am following day, Monday through Friday and 4:30 pm Friday through to 8:30 am following Monday, including statutory holidays.

Qualifications: Preference will be given to those with a B.S.W. or M.S.W., along with two (2) years

related CAS experience, and completion of the New Worker Training Foundations. Consideration will be given to those applicants with a B.A. in a related discipline and

with transferable experience from a CAS.

Remuneration: \$1,000 per work week plus 2% in-lieu of benefits, vacation paid at current legislative

provision.
