This position provides consulting services, representation and advice on employment and labour relations matters, including:

- Policies and procedures
- Grievance handling and resolution
- Mediation and arbitration
- Conflict investigation and resolution
- Collective bargaining preparation

In addition, this position will actively participate in the Labour/Management committee and co-chairs the joint health and safety committee.

The ideal candidate will have minimum of 5 years experience working in a senior labour relations role, a bachelor's degree in a related field and a CHRL. Good knowledge and understanding of the labour relations act, human rights act, ESA, health and safety act and industry trends related to HR/labour relations is essential. This position requires strong problem solving skills, excellent conflict resolution, and interpersonal skills.
