



Resource Worker

The Agency currently has a permanent full-time Resource Worker position available within the Children and Youth Services Team.

Resource Workers provide individual support, ongoing training, skill development, and coaching to foster parents. Workers assess foster family functioning to determine the most appropriate home for children and youth in the care of the Agency. Workers also co-facilitate support groups and training, participate in case conferences, plan of care meetings, and team based decision making meetings to ensure effective service delivery to families and children.

The Resource Worker provides duty coverage for the Placement Worker as necessary.

- Previous child welfare experience preferred
- Proven ability and willingness to work collaboratively
- Strong assessment skills
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
