He/she will develop the strategy and design of Peel CAS' organization wide approach to diversity, equity and inclusion.

The incumbent works collaboratively with the direct service branches to ensure that services are provided through a diversity, equity and inclusion lens. This position will implement training programs for staff and management to improve their competence on issues related to diversity, equity and inclusion.
