



CARE HOME WORKER – PERMANENT FULL-TIME

The Agency has a permanent full time CARE Home Worker position available within the CARE Home Program of the Children and Youth Services Team.

CARE Homes offer therapeutic foster care with staff supports for children and youth in care of Family and Children's Services. The worker will encourage, monitor, support and counsel up to seven (7) children/youth within CARE homes in the community; work in partnership with a multi-disciplinary/agency team to plan and facilitate skill building and activity based programming; prepare weekly reviews, facilitate and document Plan of Care meetings for each child in the home.

- Experience in a residential setting for children/youth preferred
- Current First Aid and CPR certificate and NVCI training certification preferred
