



ONE TO ONE WORKER

The Agency has a temporary part time One to One Worker position. This is a 6 month contract, working 15 hours per week – Monday to Friday 2:30pm-5:30pm.

This position will provide in-home support to a medically fragile preschool aged child to assist with daily care needs including but not limited to toileting, changing diapers, toilet training, dressing, feeding as well as provide activities that foster emotional, cognitive, social, and physical development.

The successful candidate will require access to a vehicle during their shift in order to transport this child to activities and appointments.

- An Undergraduate degree plus relevant experience in a related field, in the opinion of the Society
- Experience with medically fragile children would be an asset
- Current First Aid and CPR certificate required
