POSITION: RESIDENTIAL INTERVENTION WORKER

**LOCATION:** Central

The Central office is looking for a relief Residential Intervention Worker. The Residential Intervention Worker will play an instrumental role in implementing treatment intervention plans within each child in the program. The worker must provide adequate coverage of the house when on shift and be fully responsible for meeting the physical and emotional needs of the children and adolescents. They are responsible for working within the therapeutic team of staff, house parents, supervisor, and consultants in making treatment plans for and with the children and ensuring these plans are carried out on a day-to-day basis. The Worker will be responsible for children's competency development, behavioural management and activity programming.

- Preferred education: Bachelor of Social Work or University Degree in the Human Sciences
- Minimum education: Post-secondary diploma in the social services field
- · Experience working with children in implementing residential treatment programs
- Ability to work independently and be self-motivated
