- POSITION: **CHILDREN SERVICES WORKER**
Peterborough Children's Service
Temporary Full-time – One Year Contract (until February 2022)

- DESCRIPTION: **Position Summary:**
Reporting to the Supervisor, the Children Services Worker has the responsibility of:
- Managing a caseload of children for whom the agency is seeking a permanent plan.
 - Planning and supporting youth transitioning out of care and into adult support services.
 - Assessing and maintaining communication with family members to determine the suitability for care and reunification of the children; or to arrange appropriate access with the children.
 - Providing ongoing support, consultation with care givers and arranging for treatment and follow-up services for children according to their individual needs.
 - Ensuring required documentation is maintained on all children's files.
 - Ensuring access for children in care to services such as counselling, education, health, and social/recreational services to enhance their skills and abilities.
 - Providing direct service to children and work with agency staff to place children within the Society's care.
 - Maintain positive working relationships with collaterals and interpret the Agency role to the Community, and advocate on behalf of the children for needed services and access to community resources.
 - Work in accordance with the CYSA, Ministry Standards and Guidelines, Ontario Risk Assessment Model, Ontario Looking After Children, Agency Policies and Procedures, and the Collective Bargaining Agreement.
 - Perform other duties as may be assigned from time to time.
