Ensure children who are identified as at risk are in and remain in a safe environment and are provided with the supports and resources necessary for them to achieve their potential. Utilizing community resources to develop a Family Centered Service Plan with each family to increase their capacity to provide for their children in their own home.

Successful candidates must possess a Bachelor of Social Work and/or a Master of Social Work from an accredited post-secondary educational institution. Able to apply anti-racist, anti-ableist, anti-indigenous racism and anti-2SLGBTQIA+ lenses to social issues.
