The Job

Qualifications

- Bachelor or Masters Degree in Social work and/or registration with the College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers combined with at least 5 years of Child Welfare management experience.
- Will be responsible for the following service teams; Child in Care, Kinship, Adoption, Resource staff and therefore have corresponding experience in at least one or more of these service areas within child welfare.
- Sound knowledge of organizational behaviour and development as well as project management knowledge and experience.
- Sound knowledge of the impact and risk of social issues in child welfare and understanding of current relevant theories and best practices.
- Sound knowledge of leadership and management theories, principles and best practices.



- Excellent interpersonal skills including the ability to work cooperatively and collaboratively with internal and external resources and mediate conflict.
- Excellent listening, verbal and written communication skills.
- Strong time management skills & ability to work effectively under the pressure of tight timelines, competing priorities and emergent issues.
