## **GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

This position will assist the Manager, Finance and Administration in the preparation and completion of all the Society's financial transactions and reporting. This position will provide back up support to all accounting functions, including accounts payable, accounts receivable and cash management.

The Financial Analyst will maintain and supervise the complete financial system up to and including the production of financial statements, ensuring all entries are complete, balanced and properly authorized; review the Chart of Accounts on a regular basis and provides recommendations for appropriate revisions to the Manager, Finance and Administration; provide back up for payroll in absence of the Payroll Officer.

In addition to these tasks, the Financial Analyst will also use their analysis and forecasting skills to create financial models for decision support and identify service gaps and areas for improvement.
