## AFTERCARE BENEFITS INITIATIVE (ABI): FREE HEALTH BENEFITS FOR FORMER ONTARIO YOUTH IN CARE

## ARE YOU A YOUNG PERSON UNDER 25 YEARS OF AGE WHO WAS EITHER A FORMER YOUTH IN EXTENDED SOCIETY CARE IN ONTARIO OR ADOPTED ON OR AFTER JUNE 1, 2016?

If yes, then you might qualify for the Aftercare Benefit Initiative (ABI), a program offering health, dental, counselling and life skills support services to eligible youth at no cost.

Benefits include things like:

- prescription drugs
- dental and vision care
- professional services (e.g., massage therapy and physiotherapy)

Between 25-29 but still meet these criteria? Then you can still qualify for the counselling and life skills benefits. Learn more at <u>oacas.org/abi</u>.

- smoking cessation
- nutritional coaching
- stress management
