Cleaning Your Car

Following Transportation of a Person with COVID-19

1. Before You Start

- Put on disposable gloves.
- Avoid contact with face and contaminated areas.

2. Cleaning Products to Use



- Commonly used cleaners and disinfectants, including soap and water, are effective against COVID-19.
- If you use a disinfectant, use one authorized on the Health Canada website.



- Closely follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaners and avoid bleach except on simple plastics.
- Don't use solvents be mindful of mixing chemicals.



Disinfectant wipes are not recommended for heavily soiled surfaces. If using wipes, those labelled 'disinfecting' are suggested.

• Dashboard, radio and

- climate control buttons,
 - Power window/power door lock switches
 - Seat, seat adjuster, and car seat, if used

3. What to Clean

Pay particular attention to those areas that come most frequently into contact with people like:



- Keys or Fobs, starter button on vehicles with Fobs
- Inside and outside door handles, inside door grab handles, pads and armrests, trunk latch
- Steering wheel, shift lever, console, turn signal and wiper stalks
- touch screen (avoid products with ammonia as an ingredient, since it can strip off anti-glare/antifingerprint coatings)



Take care and apply products gently as your car interior surfaces can be delicate!
