

Secondment Opportunity

An exciting opportunity exists for you to participate in policy development and program design to support the ministry's [Child Welfare Redesign](#) strategy. The successful candidates will have a **minimum of 5-years lived experience**, specialized skills, and knowledge of **working with and within Indigenous communities and an understanding of Indigenous Data Governance, including OCAP® principles**, in addition to strong writing, research, and organizational skills; good time management practices and the ability to work in a fast-paced environment; and the ability to provide advice and guidance on good data governance practices and culturally and contextually appropriate use of Indigenous data to support the provision of coordinated, integrated and preventative government and community services.

BPS secondee would be working closely with ministry staff throughout the engagement, development and initial implementation process of the Indigenous data governance strategy, and support ministry staff in navigating the complex Indigenous data landscape and act as a bridge to achieving common desired outcomes, building capacity within the ministry to sustain the strategy going forward.

What are the available secondment roles?

- One Senior Policy Analyst to support the work of development and implementation of an Indigenous Data Strategy that would be foundational to the Child Welfare Redesign strategy.

What can I expect to do in this role?

In this role, you will:

- Review legislation and regulations related to data governance as it relates to Indigenous Data governance, including data privacy and security, and the collection, use and disclosure of personal information, including personal health information and identity-based data
- Engage with various Indigenous communities and stakeholders to co-develop and implement a sustainable Indigenous data governance strategy
- Develop collaborative relationships and liaise with stakeholders
- Conduct literature and jurisdictional scans and evaluate legislation, policies and programs in other jurisdictions
- Prepare and update materials to respond to policy and program related issues
- Use computer applications such as word processing, spreadsheets, power point, e-mail, and online collaboration tools.
