Reporting to the Senior Service Director, the Supervisor: Ongoing Services is an expert in child welfare practice related to child protection. This position oversees the delivery of child welfare services that are child centered and families focused and adhere to the policies and practices of the Children's Aid Society of London and Middlesex, Ministry standards and the Child Youth and Family Services Act. Child safety, wellbeing and permanence are the focus. This Supervisor promotes Equity, Anti-Oppressive practice and evolving CASLM initiatives including Family Based Care and Active Discharge Planning. This position is strengths based and risk aware. Key milestones and outcomes for each touchpoint in the child and family plan are co-created in collaboration with the child, youth and family as well as with CASLM team members and community partners. Community engagement and partnerships are a priority.

- Proven knowledge and skills in the delivery of child welfare services to families and children
- Experience with evidence-based practices in child maltreatment assessment and treatment

- Strong communication and presentation skills and the ability to perform during periods of multiple demands
- High tolerance for emotionally intensive work and cases
- Ability to understand, manage and take lead with extremely contentious and complex cases
- Ability to thrive in ambiguity and complexity
- Ability to lead a diverse group of workers with specific skill set
- Proven ability to work collaboratively across the agency, within the child welfare sector, and with community partners
